Level 4 Award in Supporting Children & Young People with Speech, Language and Communication Needs.

We are delighted to offer this programme in partnership with Eastern Partnership UK (SEND) and Gateway Qualifications.

The programme will enable participants to develop their knowledge and confidence and practical skills in supporting children and young people with speech, language and communication needs.

The qualification is suitable for a range of school- based practitioners including support staff and teachers. SENCOs may also wish to develop their own knowledge and skills in this area. It is suitable for all phases of education: early years, primary and secondary.

On successful completion participants will gain a Level 4 award in supporting children and young people with speech, language and communication needs. They will also gain 6 level 4 credits from Gateway Qualifications. Participants will develop a detailed portfolio of work.

The qualification is delivered via a blended learning pathway: an initial half day face-to face session and a mid-point 2 hour face-to-face workshop will support the 6 month online programme which is easily accessible via internet enabled devices including tablets and phones.

Each participant will be allocated an online Learning Outcomes Assessor who will support the completion of the programme and the portfolio of evidence. To achieve the learning outcomes for the course, participants will submit learning journal entries and assessment tasks via the online platform.

Online programme available for 6 months from October 2020. Registration with Eastern Partnership <u>MUST</u> <u>be made by 30th September</u> to ensure inclusion in the Autumn cohort.
