Course Objectives

Mastery pedagogy works on the principle that all learners will meet age-related expectations. Great teachers will support some learners as well as challenging others and deploying the LSA in supporting this practice is key. We will consider adaptation models of teaching, how tasks can be adapted to meet different needs, and good practice in modelling, questioning and supporting the teacher to achieve high expectations for all learners.

This course will consider the role of the LSA in a mastery classroom. We will explore how LSAs can fully support mastery teaching and learning and will discuss the many roles and skills that could be implemented to support the class teacher We will encourage LSAs to reflect on how they are deployed and to be confident in taking a more proactive approach. A model of ongoing, school-based professional learning will be encouraged so that learning is based specifically around the needs of the pupils being worked with so that every child can reach their full potential.
