The longer this persists the harder it becomes to bridge the gap which will mean children may struggle to access the wider curriculum. This session will help you to bridge that gap and is especially designed for KS2 teachers who have not taught phonics for a while or who lack confidence in this key area. Phonological awareness, phonics, terminology and basic procedures will all be explained and teachers will leave with a full understanding of phonics and a knowledge of how they can incorporate it into their daily practice.
