







Level 4 Award in Supporting Children & Young People with Speech, Language and Communication Needs.

This exciting initiative will enable participants to develop their knowledge and confidence in supporting children and young people with speech, language and communication needs and provide them with the opportunity to develop a range of practical skills to fulfil a school-based support role.

The qualification is suitable for practitioners working in support roles and is open to those in all phases of education; early years, primary and secondary and post 16.

On successful completion participants will gain a Level 4 award in supporting children and young people with speech, language and communication needs and 6 level 4 credits from Gateway Qualifications. Participants will take away an exciting portfolio of work. The qualification can be accessed online via laptop/tablet/phone.

The qualification is being offered in partnership with Essex Local Authority and Chelmsford Teaching Schools Alliance. The qualification is being offered via a blended learning pathway, with access to the online course materials and two workshop sessions. The workshop sessions will be delivered via an online meeting platform. Should current government policy change, the second session may be offered face to face.
